

HSA Amounts for 2019

The HSA amounts are indexed earlier in the year (normally in May) than other indexed items (normally in December). Here are the indexed amounts for HSAs for 2019 according to Revenue Procedure 2018-30.

** The CONTRIBUTION limitations for 2019 are:

Single coverage is \$3,500 (up from \$3,450 for 2018)

Family coverage is \$7,000 (up from \$6,850 or \$6,900 for 2018)

(The catch up amount for taxpayers reaching age 55 or older by the end of the year remains at \$1,000)

** A HIGH DEDUCTIBLE health plan is a plan that has an annual deductible that is not less than:

\$1,350 for self-only coverage (same amount as 2018)

\$2,700 for family coverage (same amount as 2018)

** The annual OUT-OF-POCKET expenses (deductibles, co-payments, and other amounts, but not premiums) cannot exceed:

\$6,750 for self-only coverage (up from \$6,650 for 2018)

\$13,500 for family coverage (up from \$13,300 for 2018)

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
